

Year 3 – Pumas and Jaguars

National Curriculum

As **Readers'** we will be reading Jacqueline Wilson's Cliffhanger, linking to our English work.



Our topic this half term will be **Geography** based. We will be learning about human and physical geography. Deepening our knowledge of weather, climate and biomes, developing our understanding of the impact that we have upon our planet and exploring the life and work of David Attenborough and Greta Thunberg.

Our Planet, Our World

As **Writers** we will be learning about and then writing our own Cinquain poems. We will then be using Talk 4 Writing to generate ideas for and write our own stories based upon suspense and fear. We will be using the story 'Staying Out' as our model text.

As **Scientists** we will be learning about Animals, including humans. After recapping our prior knowledge we will be focusing on the digestive system, different types of teeth and developing our knowledge of food chains.

In **RE** we will be learning about how different religions feel about the world, and what they do to help care and look after our world.

In **PSHCE** we will be focusing on financial capability. Developing our understanding of the value of money, how we receive money through a variety of means, how we can keep our money safe and what it can be used for.



As **Mathematicians** in Year 3 we will begin by focusing on multiplication and division methods and applying this to word problems. We will then be moving to learn about statistics and fractions. In Year 4 we will be exploring the properties of shape and learning about symmetry. We will then move on to decimals, money and problem solving before investigating fractions.

In **Art** we will be exploring how watercolours are made, how we can use them and different artists that use them.

As **Musicians** we will learning chair drumming and notation in Year 3. Year 4 will be learning about Samba music, working towards composing their own Samba pieces.

In **Computing** we will be using Purple Mash to learn and develop our touch typing skills. We will also be looking at and using spreadsheets.

In **PE** we will be improving our strength, stamina and agility with a fitness unit. We will also be developing our flexibility in gymnastics.

As **Linguists** we will be learning to say what we and others use in the classroom and at home.

Supporting Learning at Home

- ☺ **Mathletics:** www.mathletics.co.uk – set on Fridays and due the following Thursday.
- ☺ **Maths:** Key Instant Recall Facts (KIRFs) will be sent home to learn each half term.
- ☺ **Times Tables** A target for the end of Year 3 is for children to know the 3, 4 and 8 times tables, and by the end of Year 4 is for children to know their multiplication tables up to 12×12 . It is important for children to practise their tables regularly.
- ☺ **Spelling** Children will be provided with a spelling activity to complete at home. This will be sent home on Fridays and should be returned on the following Thursday.
- ☺ **Reading book** Ideally read **daily** for at least 10-15mins. Children should bring their reading record book to school each day.
