



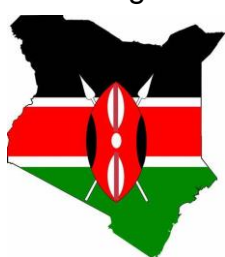

National Curriculum

As **Mathematicians** we are solving problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using a range of concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays.



As **Geographers** we will use maps, atlases, books, the internet and people to help us compare the climate, landscape, clothing, food, transport, buildings and schools in Cambridgeshire and Africa.



As **Musicians** our main focus will be listening, appraising, exploring pitch and pulse as well as performing through our online scheme 'Charanga'.

In indoor **PE** we will be exploring movement skills and balancing through Yoga. In outdoor **PE**, will be focussing on net and wall games. They use and develop skills such as throwing, catching, tracking and hitting a ball.

As **Writers** we will write our own warning tale based on Kassim and the Greedy Dragon. We will be focussing on using expanded noun phrases and other features to write creatively.

As **Readers** we will read and enjoy poetry; read, listen to and discuss stories and information texts, giving our thoughts and opinions.



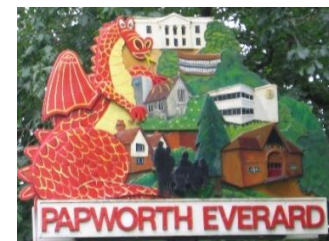

In **Computing** the children will learn how instructions relate to code and they will be creating a simple program.

As **Artists** we will be exploring African patterns, forming opinions based on these and then printing our own designs to make a class tunic.

As **Scientists** we will explore and compare the differences between things that are living, that are dead and that have never been alive. We will also learn about simple food chains.


As **Historians** we will find out about the lives of significant people from the history of Papworth Everard.



In **RE** we will learn about Christianity; finding out what Christians believe, including the Easter and Creation stories and how they care for the community.

In **PSHCE** the children will be exploring healthy and safer lifestyles by reflecting on their own lifestyles and understanding how to keep themselves healthy through a balanced diet and exercise.

Supporting Learning at Home

- ☺ **Weekly phonics/spelling** (usually given out on Mondays).
- ☺ **Maths:** www.mathletics.co.uk - Tasks set by teacher to be completed by deadline. Number facts (KIRFs) to be sent home each half-term.

PE Lessons

Ocelots will take place on **Wednesdays** (outdoor) and **Thursdays** (indoor).

A reminder that for indoor P.E. (Yoga) your child needs :

- **Shorts**
- **T-shirt**

For outdoor PE they need:

- **jogging bottoms/ leggings/ shorts**
- **t-shirt**
- **jumper**
- **trainers**

If your child has long hair, please ensure they have a hair band, as long hair must be tied back for PE. It is expected that all children can remove watches/earrings for PE. If your child is unable to remove their own stud earrings these should be removed at home on PE days or micropore tape provided from home so they can cover them. Thank you for your support with this.
