

Learning Overview for week ending 16th February

Literacy

- Introduced digraphs er, air, ear
- Practised letter formation r,n, m, p, h, b
- Introduced phase 3 words look, see, will, for, was, my, they, are, you, too
- Segmenting to spell eg sounding out a word and writing the graphemes (letters) for the sounds we hear.
- Writing simple sentences to include a capital letter, finger spaces between words and a full stop.
- Shared non-fiction books about castles.
- Writing information about castles and banquet day.
- Recounting events of Banquet day.

Maths

- Counting on to 30 and back in ones from 10, then 15.
- Counting on from a given number for example starting on 3 and counting on 4,5,6
- Using our fingers to show different numbers for example show me 2, 5 etc. Can you show the number in a different way?
- Subitising objects to 6 and spots on a dice and domino.
- Counting all spots on a domino to find the total.
- Exploring subtraction as taking away for example if there are 4 knights in front of the castle and 1 falls in the moat, how many are left?
- Ordering numbers up to 5, remove one, which is missing? How do you know?

Ideas for activities to do at home

- Use **all** phonics flashcards to make cvc words for your child to read.
- Read the school reading book at least three times a week. As they read encourage your child to read words in their wallet by sight.
- Practise reading words in the wallet by sight.
