# Year 5 – Mrs Brown, Mr Edwards (Lions), Mrs Buck and Miss Safranek (Tigers)

**National Curriculum** 

As **Readers**, we will finish reading The Storm Keeper's Island as our class reader. We will read a selection of poems for performing as well as a variety of extracts of different texts in our daily Guided Reading sessions.



As **Designers** we will be considering seasonal produce and the importance of utilising locally sources food. We will researching, designing and making our own seasonal soup.

As **Geographers**, we will study World Trade from Mexico. This will link back to our Mayans topic and look at how they used the cocoa bean, and how its popularity spread throughout the world. We will learn about primary, secondary and tertiary levels of trade.

As **Musicians**, we will be continuing to rehearse our songs for the Young Voices event next term.

In **PE**, we will further develop skills in dance and OAA (Outdoor Adventurous Activities).

As **Mathematicians**, we will be developing our understanding of mental strategies for multiplication and division and using place value to solve number problems. We will practise strategies for addition and subtraction, including formal written methods. We will then move on to learning formal written methods for multiplication and division.



# Autumn 2 Journey of a cocoa bean

In **Computing**, we will be using Purple Mash to learn to use spreadsheets.


In **PSHE**, we will be discussing the topic of 'Family and Friends'. We will then be learning about anitbullying during Anti-Bullying week.

As **Writers** we will begin by studying performance poetry - we will look at experts in the field such as Michael Rosen. Linked to our Science topic on animals, we will be writing non-fiction information texts.

In French we will be learning vocabulary associated with saying what others and I have. This includes things we have in school, comparing schools and homes and physical description. In all lessons, we will also be learning French phonics to support the development of our pronunciation.

In **RE** we will be learning about Humanism and what it means to be a humanist.

As **Scientists**, we will be learning about 'Evolution and inheritance'. We will learn to recognise that living things have changed over time and that fossils provide information about living things that inhabited the Earth millions of years ago. We will recognise that living things produce offspring of the same kind, but normally offspring vary and are not identical to their parents. We will also learn how animals and plants are adapted to suit their environment in different ways and that adaptation may lead to evolution.
