National Curriculum

As **readers**, we will be reading *The Arrival* by Shaun Tan. This is a picture book depicting a story of migration. We will be using this to inspire our writing units. In addition, we will be reading a variety of texts (fiction, non-fiction and poetry) and practice answering SAT-style questions on these in our daily Guided Reading sessions.



As **artists** we will be learning about perspective drawing. We will be learning about the vanishing point and considering the role of the horizon in our drawings.

As **historians**, we will be learning about leisure and entertainment throughout the 20th century. This is a really exciting unit where we learning about the following aspects of history and the influences that have developed them: film and television, holidaying, music, dance and toys.

As **Musicians**, we will be continuing to rehearse our songs that we will be performing at the O2 for the Young Voices event.

In **PE**, we will develop skills in football and gymnastics.

As **Mathematicians**, we will be developing our understanding of fractions. We will be looking at equivalent fractions; comparing and ordering fractions; adding and subtracting fractions; and multiplying and dividing fractions.

In **Computing** we will be using Purple Mash to create our own databases.


In **PSHE**, we will be discussing the topic of 'Financial Capability'.

As **Writers** we will be using *The Arrival* to inspire narrative and letter writing. In our narrative unit, we will be learning about the techniques used to create suspense. In our letter writing, we will be looking at the structure of a letter and focusing on character emotions. Throughout these units we will be recapping and developing our grammar knowledge.

In **French** we will be learning vocabulary associated with saying what others and I do. This includes learning about New Year traditions in French speaking countries. In all lessons, we will also be learning French phonics to support the development of our pronunciation.

In **RE** we will be learning about Buddhism. We will learn about where and when Buddhism started; their beliefs about dieties, nirvana, reincarnation and the pathways by which they follow for their life.

As **Scientists**, we will be learning about Light. In this unit, we will be covering natural and artificial sources of light, luminous materials, how we see, reflection and refraction, and the spectrum of light.

Children will be provided with a personalised spelling list. Each week they should practise and learn 10 of the words from their spelling lists.

Once they complete a card, they get to spin the prize wheel at school. Children are being encouraged to read titles from the Year 5 Recommended Reads booklist.
